

## Terms and Conditions:

Terms and Conditions 2007/08 for 11 day / 10 nights voyage to the Antarctic Peninsula, according to the standard itinerary as advertised as “Cash Flow on Ice Expedition”

As a passenger on this branded expedition “Cash Flow on Ice” you are engaging in a contract with and limited to Unique Frontiers PL ABN 57 116 651 793

1. **How to Book:** To reserve your place aboard ‘Cash Flow On Ice’ please complete the order form provided and forward this along with your deposit to Financial Freedom Institute via fax on + 61 (03 ) 9815 0728 or post to P.O. Box 2120 Hawthorn, Victoria, Australia, 3122
2. **Payment:** A deposit of 33% is payable to secure your place aboard the Cash Flow on Ice expeditions. The balance is due in 2 payments as per the provided order form.
3. **Cancellations:** If you wish to cancel your trip you need to notify Unique Frontiers P/L in writing. In case of cancellation, the following hire fee shall be payable:
  - Until and including 120 days prior to departure 25% of ticket price
  - From 119 days until and including 60 days prior to departure: 50% of ticket price
  - From 59 days until and including day of departure 100% of ticket price
4. **Cancellations:** Unique Frontiers PL reserves the right to cancel any trip prior to departure in the event there are too few booked on a particular trip. In such a case you will be given a full refund of only the tour price paid by you.
5. **Change of Itinerary:** Unique Frontiers PL and the master of the vessels, Aleksey Maryshev or Professor Multanovskiy reserve the right to cancel or alter itineraries without notice due to catastrophic weather, unfavourable political conditions and for any other reason beyond our control.
6. **FORCE MAJEURE:** Without prejudice to the provisions 3,4 and 5 for events which may occur at the day of departure (and thereafter) the vessel would be unable to carry out the intended voyage Unique Frontiers P/L shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, delay or failure in performance under this agreement resulting from an Act of God (e.g. war, uprising, natural disasters)
  - Unique Frontiers PL will endeavour to offer an alternate programme. Should this prove impossible Unique Frontiers PL is entitled to cancel the voyage. In such a case, Unique Frontiers PL may not be held financially liable.
7. Due to the long term planning of such journeys we recommend clients take out trip cancellation insurance. It is though not required by Unique Frontiers PL
8. Unique Frontiers PL also accept no responsibility for missed flights nor their consequences. We strongly recommend that international flights are fully flexible to allow for missed connections due to weather, mechanical and for any other reason.

9. Health and fitness requirements. Participants must be in good health and physical condition. We also ask that your Doctor complete the attached medical form must be completed by your doctor and returned to Unique Frontiers PL 90 days prior to departure.
10. These trips are to remote parts of the world where there is little or no medical services or hospital facilities for serious problems. Where necessary, evacuation can be prolonged, difficult and expensive. Medical and evacuation expenses will be the responsibility of the participant. Unique Frontiers PL reserves the right in its absolute discretion to refuse a participant the right to participate in a tour on medical or fitness grounds.
11. Insurance. The vessels Aleksey Maryshev and Professor Multanovskiy are fully insured including third party liability. Participants will be required to sign a release of claims and waiver of liability. All participants are required to have adequate travel and evacuation insurance for remote areas.
  - You will be required to provide us with your remote evacuation and repatriation policy number 3 months before departure.
  - Participants must be aware that some normal travel policies do not cover for some geographical areas and there may be exclusions for such activities as skiing, sailing and climbing .
12. Documentation required to be sent to us 90 days before departure:
  - Signed the waiver of liability
  - Copy right release of images taken by Unique Frontiers PL on and before the voyage.
  - Your signed doctor certificate of good health for such a journey.
  - Completed form with personal contact information and your current passport number.
  - Your remote evacuation and repatriation insurance policy number
13. Included in trip price.
  - accommodation on board in a heated cabin.
  - food to dietary requirements.
  - all port fees and local taxes.
  - use of on board equipment and life jackets.
  - use of communication equipment as per communications agreement.
  - use of zodiacs and kayaks, ice climbing, snow shoeing and camping gear.
  - use of washes and dryers aboard.
14. Exclusions from trip price.
  - personal travel insurance
  - flights and their equivalent taxes.
  - extra meals ashore, accommodation ashore, drinks at the vessel bar or other expenses not included in the itinerary.
  - communication transmission costs as per communication agreement. This will be assessed by the skipper of the trip and must be paid in cash upon completion of the trip.
  - personal clothing.
